Background of the project

In 2018, the Raising Peace Campaign (RPC) will build on from the progress made in the last 4 years. In this period, over 200 people were trained and empowered in Campaign's events, with a huge increase in networking by IVS orgs in the initiatives promoted by the Campaign (in 2016, 58 RP Camps, 15 events in the Global HR Week, 3 decentralised Peace Action Weeks). This evolution allowed to attract activists, trainers and IVS orgs willing to contribute and increase the impact on the topic.

The RPC in 2018 will consolidate the potential of the Campaign, by

- promoting a growing decentralisation of the campaign
- the empowerment of a bigger group of supporters and a Pool of Trainers
- standardizing the RP tools and implementing Impact measurement
- the consolidation of visibility and networking with stakeholders (2018 = 70 years of CCIVS).

The 2018 campaign maintains the strategic approach with 4 main focus areas:

- Peace- building;
- Rights of Migrant people and Refugees;
- Right to Food and Housing;
- Rights on Gender, Sexuality and Body.

› Strategic Action Lines:

- Empowerment (of activists and organisations);
- Action for HR & Peace (by IVS organisations);
- Networking, communication and advocacy (with civil society and stakeholders).

Empowerment for organisations: The creation of the PoT will give capacity to IVS orgs and networks to deliver good quality trainings for their leaders, and good awareness-raising workshops in their volunteering activities.

Training Activities

The main aim of the PoT is to create a group of experienced trainers in the field of Human Rights and Peace.

The sessions that will be proposed to participants will provide an understanding of general context of HRs, specific training skills and inspirations on how to improve visibility of related initiatives. The objectives of the training will be:

- to consolidate participants' knowledge on Human Rights Education and on the contributions of the IVS on the promotion of Peace and Human Rights;
- to acquire tools, methods and techniques to design and implement intercultural projects focused on HR and Peace;
- to improve team work skills, intercultural communication, cooperation
- to provide participants with communication tools for the promotion of their actions, initiatives and projects related to Human Rights and Peace.

The Training for Trainers will be coordinated by expert trainers. The participants on completion of the Training will have the possibility to apply to include their profile in the CCIVS Trainers Database which be of use to the network to identify and contact the ideal trainers according to their profile, specialization and interests.

Requirements

Experienced trainers (and junior trainers) who have been active in the Raising Peace Campaign, and want to engage in training activists, campleaders and volunteers during 2018
