What are the aims of the exchange and the activities ?

Reinforcing the participants's capacity to express one's own personality so that they appreciate and proudly claim their own plural identity.

Exploring new strategies and pedagogies which support young people in the elaboration of their own identity within a collective imagination of a plural and inclusive society.

Promoting interculturality, solidarity and social inclusion through the organization of a final exhibition valorizing what the participants will have collectively learnt and created during various workshops of ludopedagogy, radio and photography.



Partners of the exchange


The associations Alamirè and Laboratorio 53, which work daily with marginalized groups for the development of an inclusive society, empowering them through art therapies and speech therapy among other activities, will offer the volunteers the possibility to participate in photography and radio workshops, while the ONG Liscia will organize for everyone workshops of ludopedagogy, to explore together the potentialities of playing as a way to care for oneself and our fellow players and as a mean for social transformation. They are all long-lasting partners of La Città dell'Utopia, the local project of the ONG Servizio Civile Internazionale, the Italian branch of the international pacifist SCI network.

Who will participate to the Youth Exchange

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The Youth Exchange will be attended by 26 people coming from Italy, Spain, Slovenia, Hungary and Portugal :
4 young people with minor opportunities + 1 group leader per country and 1 coordinator.



What is expected from the group leader ?

To participate in Rome to the Advanced Planning Visit and to the whole duration of the exchange.

To take special care of the four participants s/he will accompany: making sure they understand all of the instructions, eventually translating them from English to the language of their sending country;

helping the youths to organize themselves, melt with the rest of the participants and handle the various emotions such an exchange can give birth to ; acting as a mediator with the rest of the group leaders's team in the resolution of eventual conflicts.

To support the coordinator, the local partners and the other group leaders with the logistic of the exchange and the creation of an enjoyable atmosphere, inclusive of every member of the whole group.
