# DESCRIPTION / OBJECTIVES / METHODOLOGY

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## DESCRIPTION

The project was born after the meeting of three structures working in complementary fields. **SCI Hellas** and **Concordia Sud-Est** are part of the Alliance network.

**Javali Company** is a professional theatrical company working on empowerment through the Theater of the Oppressed (forum theater, image theater, newspaper theater, life stories ...). It is part of the French-speaking network of companies practicing the **Theater of the Oppressed**.

These three organizations work on **migration issues**, whether by raising awareness to the general public, hosting migrants or refugees within the structure, through training projects.

A recent training grouped 3 members from these organizations in order to discuss the radicalization of young people and the polarization of our societies.

We flew over the tool of the human bookstore and the theater of the oppressed, which we wish to deepen in this training.

We want to **share our experiences and build the skills of youth workers on migration issues** and the building of a global citizenship based on humanistic values by learning and putting into practice two tools: the **human library** and the **theater of the oppressed**, which are respectively specialties of SCI Hellas and Compagnie Javali.

This real exchange of practice will lead to implementation with a real audience.

**We are proposing two trainings, one in Greece focused on the Human Library and one in France focused on the Theater of the Oppressed.**

Each training will bring together 30 people from 6 sending organizations for 9 days.

**This call for participants concerns the first phase of the project, taking place in Greece from 7 to 15 April 2020.**

*A second call for participants will be sent for the second phase of the training, taking place in France during June 2020. It's not mandatory, but we would like candidates to be available for both trainings. Please let us know in the application if you wish to participate in both trainings.*

## OBJECTIVES

- Develop intercultural skills of youth leaders, professionals and migrants
- Experiment two concrete tools of emancipation and sensitization (the Human Library and the Theatre of Oppressed)
- Develop knowledges on the concepts of empowerment, resilience, intersectionality and migrations
- Exchange good practices of each organization on the different topics of the project

## METHODOLOGY

The trainings will be based on methods and tools of non formal education, which will allow the participants to be in position of actor and animator, to intervene and to bring their experience as much as the trainers in order to stimulate an atmosphere of knowledge sharing and mutual enrichment.
